Cost

Enrichment classes cost \$125 for 8-week sessions, \$110 for 7-week sessions, and \$200 for the entire year for the band program.

Students are encouraged to pack a healthy snack each afternoon. They'll have time between 3:30-3:45pm to enjoy their snack.

Enrollment

Minimum and maximum class enrollment numbers may apply to certain enrichment clubs. Bergman Academy reserves the right to cancel any program due to lack of sufficient participation. Due to the registration format, there is a chance you'll be able to complete a registration form for a club that has already met its maximum. If this is the case, you will receive an email within 24 hours letting you know that the club is full. If the club you are trying to register for does not show up on the registration form, it is already full and no longer accepting members.

Pick-up Policy

Students will be dismissed at 4:45 pm out the front doors, to be picked up at the entrance of the school in carline. Instructors remain with their students for 10 minutes after the club ends, and all students not picked up by then will then join the After Care program. A \$15.00 charge will be incurred for any students sent to After Care.

Late Registration Policy

Registrations submitted after the stated registration deadline will be charged a fee of \$10 per enrichment club and will only be accepted if space remains in the club.

Cancellation Policy

Our Instructors are extremely dedicated to the enrichment program at Bergman Academy. They spend a lot of time preparing and planning for their clubs. Due to their hard work and preparation, we will be enforcing a cancellation policy this year. Cancellations made 10 days or more in advance of the enrichment session start date, will receive a 100% refund. Cancellations made within 3-9 days will incur a \$50 fee. Cancellations made within 48 hours of the enrichment session start date will be charged full price.

Monday Club Offerings

Chess Club: Level 1
Instructor: Katie Freerksen

Grade levels: Kindergarten-3rd Grade

Minimum Participants: 6

Description: No previous chess experience is required but preparation is encouraged. In Level I students will master the rules of chess, learn how to record their games, master simple checkmates and chess terms, and develop an understanding of basic strategic concepts. Students who are able to attend Level I for multiple sessions will gain the ability to teach others the rules of chess and basic chess tournament.

Chess Club: Level 2

Minimum Participants: 6

Description: Students must have a basic understanding of the rules of chess. In Level II students will learn tactics, openings, pawn structure, and common endgames while reinforcing and expanding on their Level I knowledge. Students in Level II will also develop transferable life skills such as self-discipline, concentration, long-term planning, and the ability to learn from their mistakes.
